Every person who lived in medieval England was regarded as a member of a manor and was under the jurisdiction of a manorial court, unless a citizen of a borough in certain generally urban towns or a cleric, or a lord of the manor himself, or failing sons an heiress lady of the manor herself, who were subject to the primary jurisdiction of the king's court, if a tenant-in-chief or of the county court if a mesne intermediate lord.
